



Let's talk about ... sex

The game to talk about sex, get to know yourself and your partner better, and to experience fun and sensuality

Rules

- Players can customize the game however they like, there are no limits to your imagination
- New questions can be added at any time
- If you don't want to answer a question at the moment, you can always say "next question"
- Both of you have the right not to answer questions without having to give a reason for why you're not answering
- Any and all terms you want to use can be used
- Thinking, not having an answer, showing emotion – whether by laughing, being nervous, being thoughtful, crying, being disappointed, being surprised, being angry ... is allowed
- Expressing your own wishes is allowed at any time during the game
- The game can be interrupted or paused at any time
- Do you want to add any rules or wishes?

How the game works

Cut out the cards, shuffle them, and stack them face down. If you feel like it, you can also glue the cards onto cardboard or laminate them to make them more stable, but simply cutting them out and putting them in a stack works just as well.

The game can be played at any time – but you may want to choose a time when you don't have any stress, don't have an appointment after, or when no other people are in the room. You can also cook together first, or set up candles and turn on music, there are no limits to the imagination. Pick a card at the start of the game and read it out loud, then the other person responds. Now either the person who drew the card can answer the same question, or the other person immediately draws a new card and asks the next question.
